If you require an online account activation letter or wish to order a barcoded letter, please contact the school office as soon as possible.

***If you are intending to change your child's eating arrangements during the term, please confirm in writing via letter or email to the office giving one week's notice.***

On Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> June the children in Key Stage 2 will have an Assembly led by Young Carers. They have sent through the following information.

*A Young Carer is a child under 18 who regularly helps to look after a family member or friend who is disabled, ill, has a mental health condition or addiction problem.*

*Children may engage in:*

- Practical tasks (cooking, housework and shopping).*
- Physical care (lifting or helping someone use the stairs).*
- Personal care (dressing, washing, helping with toilet needs).*
- Managing the family budget (collecting benefits and prescriptions).*
- Managing medication.*
- Looking after younger siblings.*
- Helping someone communicate.*

Our school can support young carers. If you, or a family member, needs support please contact Mrs Gibbs via the school office. All contact will be treated in the strictest confidence.
