School Uniform

Whilst the children continue to look smart in their uniform, a number of additional items are appearing which we would discourage. Please could we ask for your support with the following:

- The only jewellery to be worn are ear rings (studs) and watches. Necklaces should not be worn.
- It is important that the children have the correct PE kits in school.
- Hoodies are not part of our uniform, except for outdoor wear. A navy sweatshirt or navy/grey cardigan should be worn as a jumper in school.
- > Shoes should be black.
- Some very large hair bows, including 'cat ear' hair bands are now being worn. Whilst not wishing to ban them completely they are now becoming a distraction and only small ones should be worn from now on. Please keep other bows/bands at home for special occasions.

We do appreciate your support with the wearing of the correct school uniform and hope you can understand our wish to implement our policy and be consistent with everyone.
