## Below are a few reminders for the Spring term:

#### Clothing

Please put your child in clothing that they are able to manage themselves to help support independence whilst at Brambles such as Joggers and leggings and not dungarees or tights. Shoes that they are able to do themselves such as slip-on or Velcro, please no laces unless they can tie them without support. Please ensure that all of your child's belongings are clearly marked with their name (jumpers, coats, hats, etc.). Although we do try, Pre-school Staff cannot take responsibility for misplaced or missing uniforms etc. We will be sending the green bags from the children's pegs home at Half term so that their clothes can be replenished.

#### Bikes/Scooters

As the weather continues to improve we have noticed a number of children are now coming to Brambles on their bikes and scooters, we encourage biking and scootering to school and helmets should be worn. However please can we ask that these are not left in the Kids Club Garden or leaning against the school wall by the main entrance.

If you would like to leave your child's scooter or bike for collection time then please can they be placed at the grey doors in the small bike stand. Pre School cannot take any responsibility for these items if they are damaged or stolen while left outside.

#### **Pre-school Times**

It is important that children are dropped off and collected on time. If you are running late please let Brambles know by ringing or emailing on the above contact details.

Please note that if you are running late and knock on the grey door a member of staff will be with you as quickly as we can, if we do not answer immediately it will be because we are with the other children in the setting and we will be with you as soon as we are able to.

If your child is to be collected or dropped off at Lunchtime please use the grey door opposite The Green. This will also be the entrance/ exit if you are collecting or dropping off your child at any other time.

If another adult is collecting your child, please ensure that they know the collection time and entrance to use and in the interest of the children's safety please make sure a member of staff has been made aware prior to collection time.

### **Absences**

Please keep in touch and let Brambles know if your child is off for any reason; staff have a legal duty to record all absences. Please do this at least 15 minutes before the session they are due to attend. This can be done via an email to Brambles@brampton.cambs.sch.uk or a phone call and leave a voice mail 01480375063 option 2.

If your child has been vomiting or had diarrhoea, your child can return to Brambles 48 hours after their last episode in accordance with the school policy.

We would also ask that if you have given your child Calpol/Nurofen or similar medications before school you consider if they are actually well enough to attend Brambles.

Please hand any prescribed medication to a member of staff on the door so that the correct procedure can be followed and do not leave any medication in your child's lunch boxes or bags.
