At carpet time one of our Pre School friends shared some photos from their pond at home, showing us the two frogs that live in there and some of the frogspawn. We used these photos on our art table to help us create our own frogspawn and ponds using green and blue bubble printing.

In the garden we have been using our fine motor skills to push the jumping frogs down, seeing whose frog could leap the furthest across the table and then measuring the distance with tape measures.
