

Another week full of activity! On Wednesday children in Reception spent time outdoors tidying up and exploring their environment during their 'Make A Difference' day – thank you to the volunteers who were able to help. Various classes in KS2 also had a visit from some archaeologists working on the A14 who shared with the children some of their discoveries and also gave them the opportunity to learn the necessary skills. This was all provided free of charge by Highways England as part of the A14 work. We have also hosted a PE workshop for local teachers who were impressed by the behaviour and work that the children did during the session.
