School Uniform

The children have returned looking very smart at the start of term. Please can we ask for your help in ensuring that this continues with the correct uniform being worn. As a reminder this includes:

- Sweatshirts: navy blue
- Trousers / shorts: grey, black or navy (trousers may be worn by boys and girls)
- Polo shirts: navy or white
- Skirts / pinafores: grey, black or navy
- Summer Dress: navy and white checked, or navy and white striped, summer dresses.
- Footwear should be sensible black, flat shoes; high heels, boots or boot style trainers are not permitted.

All clothes should be clearly labelled with your child's name.

- Jewellery or make -up may not be worn in school, this includes nail varnish. The only exceptions are watches and studs for pierced ears. Earrings should be removed for PE or taped.
- Long hair must be tied back for PE and games.
