Safer Internet Day

As you are probably aware Tuesday was *Safer Internet Day* and the children have been doing various activities connected with this. One of these has been a questionnaire and it is clear that many children have access to a variety of devices that connect to the internet. Most are aware of rules they have at home and what to do if they are unsure about what they see or hear but there are also quite a number who claim to spend a large amount of time playing games or on social media.



One of the games that the children play is Roblox. This has become one of the most popular games for children aged between 5-10 and we have been made aware of circumstances in other schools where children have received 'in game' messages from strangers which have not been appropriate.

We recognise that it is not always easy but we would encourage all parents/carers to keep talking about how to stay safe and to be aware of what children are doing and who they are online with.
