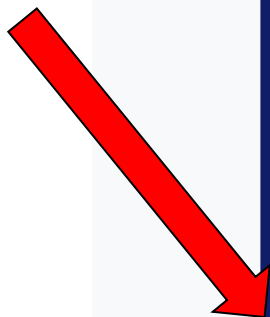



Free School Meals

Free school meals are available for all pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.

Key Tip

Even if your child is in Reception, Year 1, or Year 2 — where meals are already free for everyone — you should still formally apply if you receive qualifying benefits. Doing so ensures our school receives up to £1,480 per year in extra Pupil Premium funding.

Eligibility criteria:

Pupils who are recorded as eligible for free school meals (FSM), or have been recorded as eligible in the past 6 years (referred to as Ever 6 FSM),

Children previously looked after by a local authority or other state care, including children adopted from state care or equivalent from outside England and Wales.

Pupil premium will continue to be allocated on this basis, on the basis of household income below £7,400 (after tax, not including benefits) for the 2026/27 financial year.
