This week at Brambles we have been learning all about farms.

The art area has included a variety of collaging materials to create their own farm animals; there have been some wonderful conversations about farms children have visited and the large tractors they had seen in the fields.

In our tactile tray inside we have been using brown sand as mud and pebble letters to continue to support our phonic skills. We have also been sounding out and blending some of the farm words in our tray such as dog, cat, cow and pig. We then attempted to form some of the letters using our fingers to make the marks in the mud.
