#### Reading

We will be continuing with the Accelerated Reader system this term. Your child will be bringing home a school reading book linked to the AR system along with a reading record. Please encourage regular independent reading of this book and reading to an adult wherever possible. As a guide your child should read at least five times a week at home and should be also aiming to read 100+ minutes each week. This will support your child in working towards meeting AR targets. Extra reading of home fiction, non-fiction, magazines and guides is of course encouraged and welcomed.

### PE days/kits

PE kits will be required on Tuesday and Friday for all classes.

Please ensure that your children arrive wearing their PE kits on these days.

PE kit consists of - a white t-shirt, trainers, jogging bottoms/dark shorts and a sweatshirt. Please note hoodies are not suitable for PE lessons.

**No jewellery** should be worn for all PE activities. It is not acceptable to use tape to cover earrings, we would therefore advise that children leave any earrings at home on their PE day. Long hair must be tied back.

#### Parental Help

At home, please support your child in the learning of their times tables in preparation for their National test in June.
