During our key stage assemblies this week, we revealed something pretty special to the children – we're going to be welcoming a GB athlete to visit us! His name is Sean Rose, and the children were absolutely buzzing when they found out. It's a fantastic opportunity for our pupils to meet someone who's achieved at such a high level and to be inspired by his journey. We can't wait to see the energy and enthusiasm this visit will bring to our school community.

On a similar note of celebration, I'm absolutely delighted to announce our new Tree Captains and Vice-Captains for the year ahead. These pupils have shown real leadership potential and a genuine commitment to supporting their Tree Families. 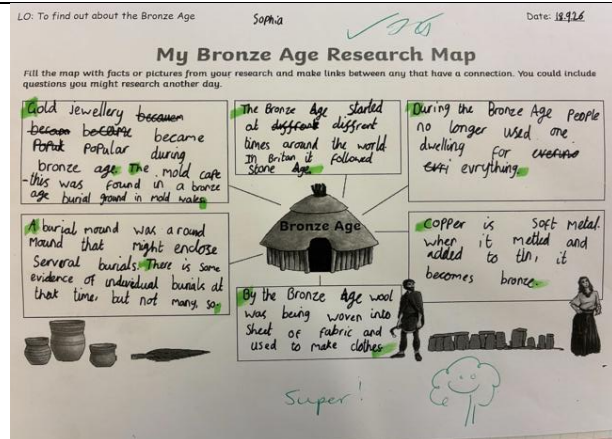

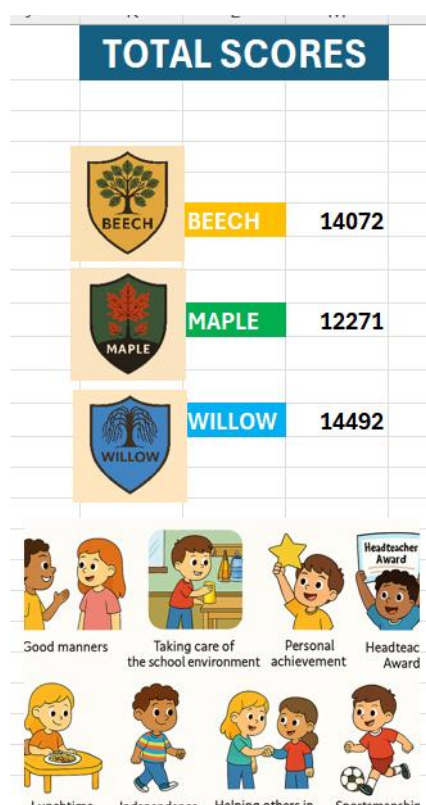
Part of Skara Brae house	Similarities to your house	Differences to your house
Bed	It is a rectangle.	It is not made out of stone.
Hearth	We have heating.	I don't have a open fire.
Dresser	I have some thing to keep my stuff in.	It is not made out of stone.
Storage boxes	We have things like Jewellery to store.	It is not so small.
Seats	It has a square shape.	It is not made of stone.

Complete the table showing what the evidence found at Skara Brae tells us about life there in the Stone Age.

Evidence Found	What it tells us
Animal bones, barley and wheat	That they farmed and killed animals. That in the Neolithic they farmed. That in the Paleolithic they hunted. Meat and still did it in the Neolithic.
Carved stone objects	They made furniture and weapons to kill animals like arrow heads, spears and axes.
Fish and shell-fish remains	They made Jewellery and made little baby toys and things of other super Peculiar items. they not kept the fish in a box!
Jewellery	They probably used stone and fish bones and made some sort of string to keep them.
No weapons	There were no weapons to kill humans. So it is a happy place!

Harvest Assembly donations

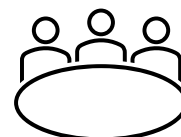

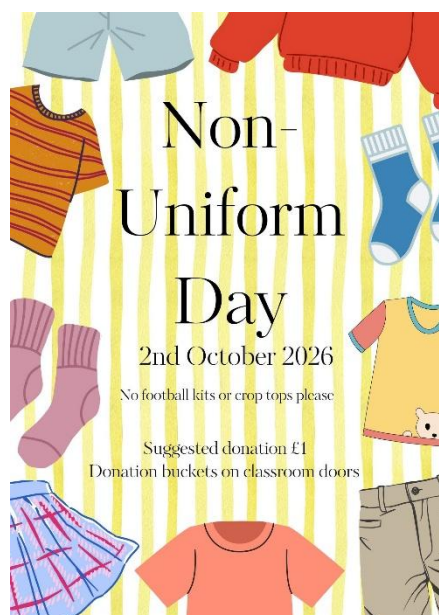
