Dear Parents/Carers,

Music	In the Summer term, we continue to build on the knowledge of playing the recorder, following on from year 3. Later in the term, we will also be learning how to play the Ukulele, following basic chords using tab notation. Children will develop their problem-solving skills as well as perform as a group.

MFL	Spanish – Clothes & Habitats

Homework

Children will be set an open-ended task every term. They are expected to read, practice their times tables and spellings everyday for around 5 minutes or more.

Reading

We will be continuing with the Accelerated Reader system this term. Your child will be bringing home a school reading book linked to the AR system. They can take their weekly AR test at home or at school. Please note children ARE allowed the book when they do the test. Please encourage regular independent reading of this book and reading to an adult wherever possible. As a guide your child should read at least five times a week at home and should be also aiming to read 100+ minutes each week. This will support your child in working towards meeting AR targets. Extra reading of home fiction, non-fiction, magazines and guides is of course encouraged and welcomed.

PE days/kits

PE kits will be required on Monday and Thursday for all classes.

Please ensure that your children arrive wearing their PE kits on these days.

PE kit consists of - a white t-shirt, trainers, jogging bottoms/dark shorts and a sweatshirt. Please note hoodies are not suitable for PE lessons.

No jewellery should be worn in for all PE activities as it is no longer acceptable to use tape to cover earrings. We would therefore advise that children leave any earrings at home on their PE day. Long hair must be tied back.

Parental Help

At home, please support your child in the learning of their times tables in preparation for their National test in June. Your child has access to T.T.Rockstars which is designed to be a fun way to learn and practise. Other websites that will also help include: Top Marks (Hit the button) and www.timestables.co.uk. For spellings, all children have a log in to Spelling Shed which they need to log into daily to practice the games and spelling patterns. They also need to complete their assignments daily rather than in one sitting.
