Reading

We will be continuing with the Accelerated Reader system this term, but will no longer be using Reading Records. Your child will be bringing home a school reading book linked to the AR system. Please encourage regular independent reading of this book and reading to an adult wherever possible. As a guide, your child should read at least five times a week at home and should be also aiming to read 100+ minutes each week. Extra reading of non-fiction, such as magazines, instructions and news articles is of course encouraged and welcomed.

PE days/kits

PE kits will be required on a Monday and Thursday for the first half term. Please ensure that your child arrives wearing their PE kits on these days.

PE kit consists of: a white or blue t-shirt, trainers, jogging bottoms/dark shorts and a sweatshirt.

No jewellery except stud earrings and watches should be worn in school and these must be removed for all PE activities as it is no longer acceptable to use tape to cover earrings. We would therefore advise that children leave any earrings at home on their PE day. Long hair must be tied back.
