BVPS Year 5/6 Remote Learning Update 2021

As we move into another phase of remote learning, Year 5 and 6 will once again be using the tools available to us within Office 365.

Please make sure you have your username and password for this and all other online tools and resources we use at school (Office 365, STARZ, TTRS, AR, Nessy (if you use it), Touch Typing, Code.org etc). If you need any of these details please contact your class teacher via STARZ, the class email or Teams chat (instructions at the end of this document).

You have all used these tools successfully both in school and at home, so hopefully you will remember how to use them.

Our basic timetable is shown below;

Nessy - children will be expected to access for 20 mins each day.

As you can see, you will have a range of tasks to complete each day, **including a teacher-led video lesson at 10am every day (orange columns)**.


Teacher-led video lessons

You will also need to log in to a Teams video call with your class teacher each day for teacher-led lessons. These will be at 10am every day and cover a different subject focus.


For Teacher-led English and round-up sessions you will have lessons with your normal class teacher.

For Teacher-led Maths lessons you will have video lessons with your Maths teacher.


Each Teacher's video links can be found within the **Content Library > Class information** folder of your class notebook.

When you click the link to join you may see the following message;





You now have two options;

Each subject focus has a Section within the Content Library.


We are not using the class notebook folders this time. You will only need to access the resources within the Content Library.

Completing work - Using a Shared Word Document

You will be completing all your work whilst away from school within a **Shared** Word Document.

These have been created by your class teacher and have been shared with you.

Once logged in, these should appear within your 'Shared with me' section on your home page.



As you can see you have three Word documents for each main subject focus.

You will complete all of your work in these documents.

- All maths work will be completed in the Maths document
- All the English tasks in your English document
- All other work in your Creative document

They are shared with your teacher who will look at and comment on your work as appropriate.


For each piece of work;

- (1) Put the date and LO in the document.
- (2) For some work you will work directly in the word document but for others you may need to work on paper or print something out.
- (3) Either write on the document or if you have worked on paper or printout, take a photograph of your work and insert it onto the page in the appropriate place.

Communication during Remote Learning

During lockdown there are three main ways you can contact your class teacher;

- (1) **STARZ** Use the message function as normal.
