The Brambles have really enjoyed our nature topic this week where we have been exploring rainbows. We discovered that a rainbow is created when sun light is bent and refracted while entering a droplet of water; it then splits into the seven separate colours.

While the sun was shining we used some glass prisms to create our own rainbows in the garden, we made rainbows on the ground, our friends' jumpers and the benches.

During group time we performed our own rainbow science experiment using coffee filters and water.

It was very exciting to investigate the colours moving over the arc. Perhaps at home you could try this experiment.
