
### Sports News

You won't be dropped in the deep end either, we've got loads of information from previous years and we'll be there to guide you. This would be a great opportunity for those that want to get involved but cannot commit to a full committee position as it's event specific. **Why not get a couple of friends together - everything is more fun when you do it with friends!**
