Happy New Year and welcome back to Brambles, we hope that you all had a wonderful Christmas. This week we have been learning all about hibernation and hedgehogs.

Our small world area has included different animals that hibernate, with various textures and building materials for us to create our own shelters that would protect them from the cold.

On our art table we have been practising our scissor control skills by cutting out our own hedgehogs and adding spines by snipping small cuts along their backs. During carpet time Brambles have been using their listening ears to explore a variety of sounds around the environment such as animals, weather and household items.

Our maths area in the garden has included numbered hedgehog shapes and pegs, we have been practising matching numeral to quantity while giving our hedgehogs some spines.
