## Homework

### Reading

We will be using the Accelerated Reader (AR) system this term. Your child will be bringing home a school reading book linked to the AR system. Please encourage regular independent reading of this book and reading to an adult wherever possible. As a guide your child should read at least five times a week at home and should be also aiming to read 100+ minutes each week. Extra reading of home fiction, non-fiction, magazines and guides is of course encouraged and welcomed.

### Spellings

Spellings will be issued each week and children will need to practise their spellings using Spelling Shed. They will be expected to complete at least five games each week.

### Times Tables

Children will also need to learn their times tables using TT Rock Stars, Top Marks, Times Tables.co.uk or by using any other means.

### Learning Logs

Children will be set an open-ended task every two weeks (approximately). Children will be given the opportunity to share their learning with their friends in class. We have been really impressed with the summer reading projects that the children have already brought in.
